Every student must be in full uniform whether he or she is in school, on campus, or under the school's jurisdiction, including all school-sponsored activities, whether on- or off-campus, such as field experiences, academic competitions, and school-sponsored social and recreational events. TOPS	POLO or CREW NECK STYLE <i>long or short sleeve</i>	Solid red, white or navy blue & have NO LOGO unless logoed with CIS. SHOULD have one white polo with CIS logo
	BLOUSES and OXFORDS <i>button down & long sleeve</i>	Solid white, navy or Oxford blue
	SWEATERS <i>pull-over, turtleneck or cardigan</i>	Solid red, white or navy blue
	LAYERED WEAR <i>sweatshirts or fleece, sweaters or lightweight jackets</i>	Solid red, white or navy blue. May have CIS logo, small logo, or plain for layered wear only
	HEAD WEAR <i>caps, hats, & hoods</i>	Should NOT be worn inside the school building
BOTTOMS	DRESSES, SKIRTS, SKORTS <i>no shorter than 3 inches above knee</i>	Solid khaki/navy or plaid of khaki/navy
	PANTS <i>cargo or dress</i>	Khaki or Navy
	SHORTS <i>cargo, dress or walking</i>	Khaki or Navy
	HOSIERY, TIGHTS, OR LEGGINGS <i>may be worn with skirts or jumpers</i>	Solid black, navy, brown, white or red (no neon)
	SOCKS	Solid black, navy, brown, white, red (no neon)
SHOES	ATHLETIC	Standard athletic shoes
	BOOTS <i>should be covered by pants leg</i>	MUST be no higher than mid-calf if worn with a dress, jumper, skirt or skorts.
	DRESS	MUST be close-toe and close-heel.
PE	PE SHIRT	Gold, blue or other CIS t-shirts acceptable
	Athletic Shorts <i>no shorter than 3 inches above knee</i>	Solid color gold or navy
